

# Baltimore Community ToolBank

## Environmental Resiliency

### Accomplishments:

- Initiated recycling of #2 and #5 plastics as sole collection site in Baltimore City in partnership with Upcycled.
- Repurposed 908,350 gallons of stormwater runoff onsite.\*
- Washed 1,540 tools using gray water.
- Maintained single-use plastic bottle ban on campus.
- Supplied onsite volunteers with 560 reusable water bottles.
- Maintained 8 floating wetland units in Baltimore's Inner Harbor at the Waterview Marina.
- Hosted 4 rain barrel workshops onsite in partnership with Baltimore City Department of Public Works, engaging 55 households and 67 participants.
- Upcycled 90 cardboard boxes as weed cover in ToolBank Rain Gardens.
- Removed 1,441.96 pounds of litter from 1200 block of Wicomico Street in SW Baltimore.

\*Includes ToolBank Rain Gardens and Stormwater Factory systems as assessed by BioHabitats, Inc. on annual rainfall measured at BWI Airport. 24,500 gallons of stormwater repurposed on site per inch of precipitation.



## 2024 Accomplishments con't:

- Hosted 9 environmental education field trips with 7 education partners.
- Hosted 34 environmental volunteer projects with 23 partners.
