FROM THE DIRECTOR

Funding drives the work of non-profits, and 2025 was a bit of a roller coaster for nearly every non-profit organization. At the same time, the problems our members address have not gone away. These organizations are being asked to do more with less, which is what the Baltimore Community ToolBank was built for. Our unique position means we are equipped to make a widespread impact and our program stretches every dollar further. Every dollar invested in the ToolBank is quadrupled into value provided. **Shared tools mean shared strength.**

While it is a testament to our program that we have wheelbarrows in good working order after a decade of service, 2026 is going to be a year focused on upgrading our tool inventory. Excitingly we've begun securing funding to invest in membership outreach to guide our program to make sure we have the tools that our members need!

The value of the ToolBank lies in the sheer breadth of community-led projects and events our partners tackle with Blue Tools. When a partner knows they have thousands of tools that are clean, sharp, and ready for their projects, they aren't afraid to scale up; they take on previously impossible projects, and **they dream differently.**

This is what we saved partners in 2025.

This value we provide is the \$1,737,725.68 in retail value of tools we loaned less our tool handling fees (1 /20th of retail).

This doesn't include the value of the space saved in our member's basements, the time saved sharpening pruners, and the effort saved cleaning tools.
